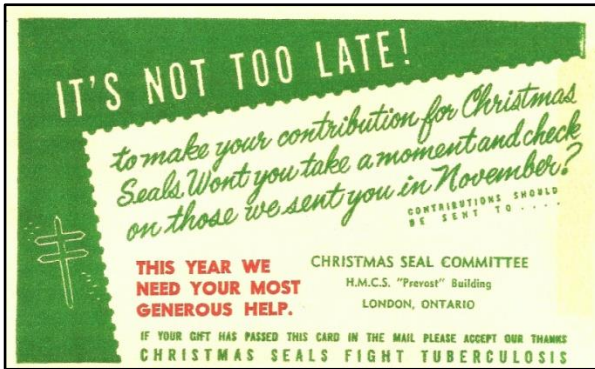


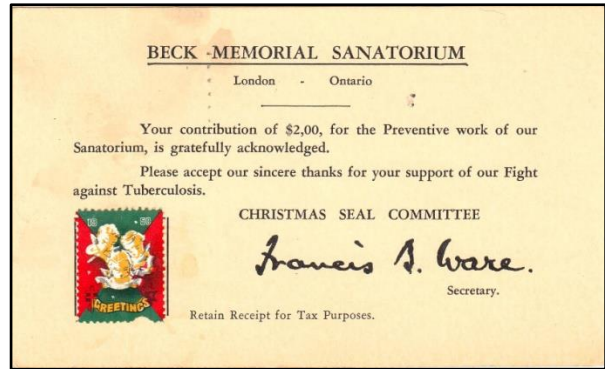
*Arthur Klass' Christmas Seal Ads on Canadian Postcards, 2<sup>nd</sup> edition*

Since the printing of the 2<sup>nd</sup> edition in March 2016, four new cards have been reported.



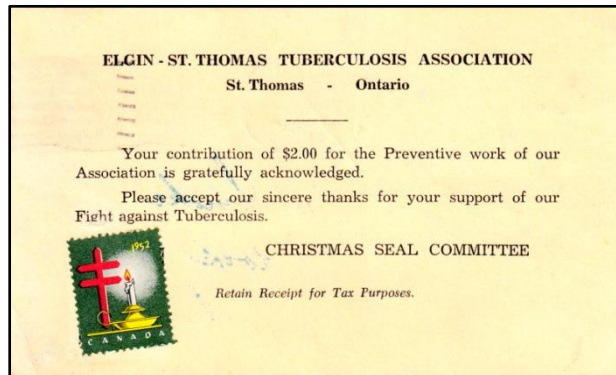

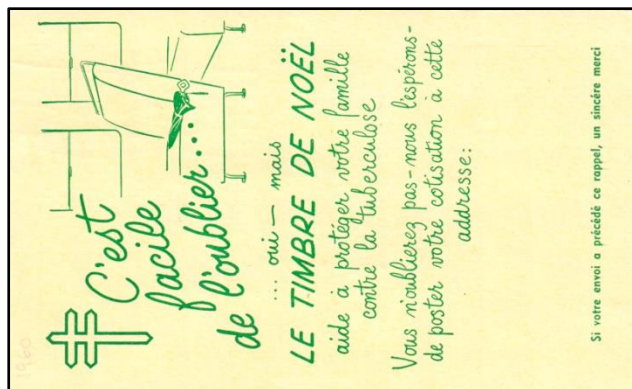

.495	Contribution acknowledgment card with 1952 seal attached (postmarked ST. THOMAS, ONTARIO CANADA FEB. 3 1953)

<b>P83a</b>	<b>2¢ First Karsh, green, type 1</b>
.225	Same as .210 but printed in green (postmarked ARVIDA P.Q. DEC 22, 1960)
