

The above postcard has been submitted to Bob Lee with a possible Unconfirmed Unofficial Duplex postmark. It bears an ARNPRIOR / ONT. split circle dater and a two ring target killer at the 3 o'clock position. Is this a coincidental placement of the dater and killer to emulate a duplex? Bob appeals to collectors of Ontario town postmarks to check their holdings for a match to the above postmark. He would appreciate a good photocopy to confirm that this might be a new rare duplex, to be catalogued.

Bob Lee reports a second known example of formerly Unconfirmed Unofficial Duplex #17 - GEORGETOWN, ONT. / CANADA with a four line date SEP/16/1881/AM. He has now moved this Duplex to the Unofficial Duplex section of his catalogue with the description as follows: - DUN-13A GEORGETOWN, ONT. / CAN. Type II V3 29 mm.

ERD 1881/09/16/AM LRD 1881/10/03/? Formerly Unconfirmed #17, Note - CAN. not CANADA.

The confirming example is a far superior strike to the first reported example. It was sold in Bob's auction of January 18, 1992 - Lot #927. Congratulations to the new owner of a very fine item of postal history.



DAB-153 COUTTS / ALBERTA is in use again!! Has this hammer been lying in the back of a drawer for a number of years? Daily use is noted since 12 II / 92. The catalogue report for L.R.D. is 1969/07/02.

Your editor notes that postmarks in use at this busy crossing on the Alberta / Montana boundary for the past three years have been the CDS type C steel hammer and the POCON 572713 square rubber dater - sharing about equal use. Current strikes from the duplex hammer indicate it is still in good condition and should give a few more years of service. Can anyone report dates of use from this hammer in the 1970's and 1980's ?
