Permanent Domestic envelope, November 2014


Another issue, previously overlooked, was called to our attention by Robert Lemire. It is a number 10 envelope. For more information, we refer you to the associated issue of PS Notes, Vol 26, No. 5. The product number is 101671; it is a "Permanent" issue, always good at the current domestic rate. The current price for this envelope is \$1.19, and it was made available in November 2014. The envelope has side seams, the usual maple-leaf security printing, and is distributed to post offices in bundles of 25. The form date on the first copies is 09.15.14.

Permanent, always worth the going rate

Dimensions: 105 mm x 241 mm (4.13 in. x 9.5 in.)

The stamp die is the flag design formerly used in 1995.
