Brockville - Peter Logan has AM/JA20/98 on a 3c s.q.

Westville - the first Map cover report (date not legible) from Savaka Trading in Thailand.

Danville - 1906 use (DE26) on a #89 franked picture postcard, reported by Rick Hills.

Lotbiniere - an accumulation of about 17 covers with receiving marks (all addressed to the same family, with dates in the 1896-1901 period) was recently dispersed on ebay. Numbers known in the handbook must be revised.

Brampton - I have just discovered that I have 1/OC 2/93, don't know where it came from.

London - the AM/FE 0/95 variety has been known for some time. A cover (double weight) to England is reported with MR 6 arrival, we are guessing the error occurred on FE20. The franking is 2c + 8c small queens, most unusual (Bill Radcliffe).

Paris - day reversed on A/ MY02/97 on cover with MY20 Drumbo receiver, Rick Hills.

Perth - Peter Logan has nude -/- -/- on 3c small queen.

Smiths Falls - Peter L. reports 1/JY14/00 on a 1c Numeral.

Thornbury - inverted 4 in day on -/MR 4/96, Peter L.

Whitby - Bruce K. reports -/JU16/? on a 5c small queen, presumably 94, late Period I use.

N&W No.2 - Peter Logan has inverted TSEW on a Map.
