NEW REPORTS

Precursor Montreal Hmr.2 – Laurent Belisle has an 1898 example showing MR16A7, but the cover (3c Numeral + 5c Leaf) left Mal Bay on OC14/98, transited Perce on DE13, shows a Q57 railway on DE14 and ended up in New York City on DE19. Evidently the MR is an error for DE. Why it took 2 months to travel from Mal Bay to Perce is not explained.

Hmr.3 – Laurent also has 2 late uses DE23A10/00 receiver from Salonika and MY10A10/01 (transit from Salonika to New York).

St.John's NF – I found the latest known strike 27 JY 99 in Bill Radcliffe's collection, receiver on a double rate cover from Halifax with 4 Maps & a 75.

Type 2 Wolfville – nude strike as killer on 5c Leaf cover to India (MR 3/98 splitring dater free strike), Bruce Kalbfleisch.

Fredericton – I found MP/SP28/96 (on 3 cts.) in Frank Hoyles' stock & believe it is the 1895 error listed in the 4th Edition.

Angus - late use on -/DE21/98 (3c numeral), reported by Scott Wiggins.

Belleville III - late use on 2/MR27/99 on a 10c SD, received from Eric Lerner.

Dundas - inverted month on PM/9 ED/95 (postcard), reported by 'arcticcan'.

Formosa II State 2 - Bill Radcliffe has a Map cover (the first such report) dated JU/22/99.

Mount Brydges - 1901 use on -/MY 25 (2c red cover), Bruce K.; 1905 use on -/DE22 (89 postcard) seen on eBay.

Niagara Falls South - 1900 use on -/JA17 (2c red), seen @ the CSDA show by Dave Robinson.

Orangeville – month missing on -/- 5/93 (postcard, Bill Radcliffe).

Thamesford – in 1904-5 several additional zero spacers have been reported: JY04/04, OC03/05, NO02/05, NO03/05, DE08/05.

Thornhill - 1905 use on a postcard AM/AU14, CSDA show/ Dave Robinson.

Waterloo - AM use in 1922 on JUL10, 2c red, CSDA, Dave R.

Wingham II - digit missing in year on -/AU14/9 (3c Jub), seen on eBay.

Regina - a late 1898 strike on 8c Numeral has been reported.

Revelstoke – it was reported @ the Halifax meeting that a second example of this hammer exists, I am attempting to get the date shown
