NEW REPORTS

Halifax I – year error on 4/NO27/28 (yes 28!) on 1c s.q. (must have been a pretty good party on the 27th), seen on eBay.

Wolfville - I have a 1904 date on a Map; the month/day are not clear but the partial 04 is clear, I've had this stamp for 4 years & just now noticed the date. Can anybody shed some light on this phenomenon? 2c Ed would seem to be a possibility.

Aylmer (East) – 94 inverted on 49/OC 3/- on 1c s.q., reported by Dave Robinson (was the report in the 3rd Edition incorrect?),

Laurentides – inverted month on -/ED 5/07 (1c Ed on postcard). Late use on -/DE29/09, receiver on card from Montreal DEC30/5PM/1909, appears to be date error, Dave R.

Pointe a Pic – Dave also has early use on -/JY25/93. free strike on piece.

Brampton - Dave also has a cover with backstamp -/JA11/94 but was sent from Niagara Falls on JA11/95 (confirming correspondence enclosed).

Gore Bay - another 3-letter month on JUL30/10 on 2 cents (Bruce Kalbfleisch).

Kingston – another date arrangement variety on 4/28SP/94 (postcard, Jacques Forbes).

Ripley - another zero spacer on AM/JA03/00 (Map), Bruce K.

Whitby - first use period extended to AU2/94 (postcard, Bill Radcliffe).

Wellington – backstamp on cover from Belleville (II) 3/DE31/94 reads -/AJ 1/59, seen on eBay. At least the 9 was right side up.

St. Boniface – Dave Robinson reports on usage periods: -/MR31/97 (new late), AM/OC16/97 (new early), AM/AP 4/98 (new late), -/MY 5/98 (new early).

Victoria – a MR 98 date on a Leaf overprint, it would seem the 'revaluing' was done at a later date.

High Street Fake – doubly a fake this time, the 2c small qn has been bisected (Dave R.),

Unknown city - this 2.00 jub has a very strange timemark. (fake fake?)
