- An additional strike dated W/MY 28/19 was reported in RA-161
- Based on input from experts in RPO cancels, it is likely that strikes with '19' in the bottom slot are actually 1900 year dates, rather than 1919, where the clerk, possibly lacking a '00' slug used '19'
- The normal period of use for the 2c red Numeral issue would support this interpretation and, by 1919, the clerk would be more likely to have used the train number, not the direction, in the top slot (as seen in 1911)
- Non-squared circle covers from 1900 are known where other RPO clerks used '19' as a year slug for 1900
